# The type of personal information we collect

We receive, collect and store any information you enter on our website or provide us in any other way. If you send a message via the website, we will collect personally identifiable information, including name, email, comments and feedback.

We use Google Analytics software tools to measure and collect session information, including page response times, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information, and methods used to browse away from the page. However, this is not personal information and you cannot be identified from the Google Analytics software.

## How we collect your information

When you send a message on our website, as part of the process, we collect personal information you give us such as your name and email address. This is sent to an officer in the Club in order to respond to your enquiry.

# Why we collect the information

We collect non-personal and personal Information for the following purposes:

- 1. To be able to contact you in response to your enquiry (personal);
- 2. To understand the use of the website and preferences (non-personal);
- To create aggregated statistical data and other aggregated and/or inferred nonpersonal information, which we may use to improve the website experience (nonpersonal)

# How we store your personal information

Our company is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to promote Brymbo Cricket Club to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall. Once your response has been responded to, your details will be removed from our platform.

#### **Use of Cookies**

We use cookies on its site. A cookie is a text file that identifies your computer to our server. Cookies in themselves do not identify the individual user, just the computer used. Cookies are **not** used to collect any personal information.
